[English] Chōhō 5th Year [1043 CE] 1st day of the 1st month

1st

Shinbō [28th day of the sexagenary cycle]. Skies were clear. On that day the Chōhai rite was held at Ichijoin. Minister of the Left [Fujiwara no] {Michinaga}. Minister of the Right [Fujiwara no] {Akimitsu}, Palace Minister [Fujiwara no] {Kinsue}, Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Michitsuna, Supernumerary Senior Counselor Lord [Fujiwara no] Sanezane, Senior Counselor Fujiwara no Kanetada, Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Tokimitsu, Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kintō, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Tadannobu, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Takaie, Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Arikuni, Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Kanehira, Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Tadasuke, Advisor Minamoto no Toshikata, [Advisor] Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari, Junior Third Rank Lord Taira no Chikanobu, and Lord Fujiwara no Kanetaka [all] arrived at their seats in the guardpost of the Right Inner Palace Guards. During the first quarter of the double-hour of the Ram [13:00-15:00], they moved to the Council of State Servants' Ouarters and so put on their shoes. They made the middle west gate into the Shōmei Gate and placed the stool for the Noble in Charge outside the gate in the southern corridor on the southwest side. [Also] on the southwest side, ministers and others [of the Council] arrived at their stools. The highest ranked person sat to the north. On the south side of the garden they placed the benches (with seats for the junior counselors and controllers, for junior secretaries of the Council, for the junior secretaries of the Controller's Office, and for the Council scribes and messengers). At the west end, there was a 15-meter tent that served as the guardpost. The chamberlains lined up there. During the double-hour of the Rooster [17:00-19:00], all participants moved to [the garden in front of the Shishiden] to present salutations [to His Majesty]. Details are in a separate record.

2nd day. Jinshin [29th day of the sexagenary cycle].

3rd day. *Kishi* [30th day of the sexagenary cycle]. It was cloudy and there was light of rain. That evening there were special banquets hosted by the crown prince and queen consort. Various senior nobles went to the residential palace [to attend].

4th day. $K\bar{o}go$ [31st day of the sexagenary cycle].

5th day. *Itsubi* [32nd day of the sexagenary cycle]. The Promotions in Rank Ceremony took place. The Minister of the Left, Inner Palace Minister, Supernumerary Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Sanesuke, Senior Counselor Lord [Fujiwara no] Kanetada, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Tadanobu, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Takaie, Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Arikuni, Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Kanehira, Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Tadasuke, [Advisor] Lord Minamoto no Toshikata, and [Advisor] Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari went to the residential palace. Rain fell late at night. In the double-hour of the Boar [just after 9 in the evening], when everything was finished, all withdrew [from the palace].

6th day. *Heishin* [33rd day of the sexagenary cycle]. Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Takaie and Advisor Lord Minamoto no Toshikata went to the residential palace. There was a request to His Majesty to seal the certificates of rank. As night fell, they withdrew.

7th day *Teiyū* [34th day of the sexegenary cycle]. The sky became cloudy, and it rained. This was the day of the White Horse Royal Banquet. Minister of the Left, Inner Palace Minister, Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Michitsuna, Supernumerary Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Sanesuke, Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kanetada, Middle Counselors Lord Fujiwara no Tokimitsu and Lord Fujiwara no Kintō, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Tadanobu, Lord Fujiwara no Takaie, Counsel of State Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Arikuni, Lord Fujiwara no Kanehira, Lord Fujiwara no Tadasuke, Lord Minamoto no Toshikata, Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari, Junior Third Rank Lord Taira no Chikanobu, and Lord Fujiwara no Kanetaka entered the residential palace. The inner and outer controllers were present. As for the court records, there is a separate journal.

8th day *Bojutsu* [35th day of the sexegenary cycle]. It was sunny in the morning, but the sky became cloudy during the afternoon, and it snowed a little. This day was the beginning of the New Year's Buddhist Assembly. Supernumerary Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Sanesuke, Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kintō, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Tadanobu, Counsel of State Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Tadasuke, and Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari, entered the residential palace. There was a ceremony in the Hall of the Eight Ministries Chōdōin. Dress for the various officials were as usual. However, the particulars are in a separate journal.

9th Day, *Kigai* [36th day of the sexagenary cycle]. The sky was clear. The noble in charge did not come to the residential palace.

10th day, *Kōshi* [37th day of the sexagenary cycle]. The sky was clear. The Minister of the Right, the Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Tadanobu and the Advisor Lord [Fujiwara no] Yukinari all came to the mansion of the minister of the left. This was because there was a grand banquet.

11th Day. *Shinchū* [38th day of the sexagenary cycle]. The sky was clear. The Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kanetada and Advisor Lord Tadasuke entered the residential palace.

12th Day. *Jinin* [39th day of the sexagenary cycle]. The sky was clear.

13th Day. *Kibō* [40th day of the sexagenary cycle]. Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kanetada, Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kintō, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Tadanobu, and Advisor Lord Minamoto no Toshikata entered the residential palace.

14th Day. *Kōshin* [41st day of the sexagenary cycle]. The New Year's Buddhist Assembly came to an end. The preparations for the seasonal banquet were as is usual. The Minister of the Left {Michinaga}, Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kintō, Advisors Lord Fujiwara no Arikuni, Lord Fujiwara no Tadasuke, Lord Minamoto no Toshikata, and Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari entered the State Halls Compound. The details are in a separate record.

15th day. *Isshi* [42nd day of the sexagenary cycle]. The sky was clear, with occasional rain. The Minister of the Left went to the residential palace. The Women's Promotions in Rank Ceremony was held. Around the double-hour of the Boar [around 9], everyone withdrew.

16th day. *Heigō* [43rd day of the sexagenary cycle]. Women's Dance and Song Royal Banquet. Supernumerary Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Sanesuke, Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kintō, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Tadanobu, Advisors Lord Fujiwara no Arikuni, Lord Fujiwara no Kanehira, Lord Fujiwara no Tadasuke, Lord Minamoto no Toshikata, Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari, Junior Third Rank Lord Taira no Chikanobu, and Lord Fujiwara no Kanetaka attended. All was prepared as usual. The details, however, are in another record.

17th day. *Teibi* [44th day of the sexagenary cycle]. Clear skies. The Grand Archery Ceremony was held in front of the *Kenrei* Gate. Supernumerary Middle Councilor Lord Fujiwara no Tadanobu, Advisors of the Council of State Lord Fujiwara no Arikuni, Lord Fujiwara no Tadasuke, Lord Minamoto no Toshikata, and Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari entered the Great Courtyard. In the evening, they withdrew.

18th day. *Boshin* [45th of the sexagenary cycle].

19th day. *Kiyū*. [46th of the sexagenary cycle]. Today the Archery Matches were held. The preparations by officials were the same as always. At the Ichijoin Mansion, the royal seat was placed at the northernmost place in the southern corridor of the east wing. The Minister of the Left, Minister of the Right, Minister of the Inner Palace, Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Michitsuna, Supernumerary Senior Counselor [Lord Fujiwara no Sanesuke?], Middle Councilor Lord Fujiwara no Tadanobu, Advisors Lord Fujiwara no Arikuni, Lord Fujiwara no Kanehira, Lord Fujiwara no Tadasuke, Lord Minamoto no Toshikata, and Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari arrived. In the evening, around the double-hour of the Boar [9pm-11pm], three rounds [of

archery] were complete. At that time the Left had won and thus they performed the Ryōō [song and dance]. When things were finished everyone dispersed.

20th day. *Kōjutsu* [47th day of the sexagenary cycle].

21st day. *Shingai* [48th day of the sexagenary cycle]. The sky was clear. The Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Tokimitsu, Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kintō, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Tadanobu, Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Arikuni, and Lord Minamoto no Toshikata reached the their places in the Council Secretaries' Office, and attended to affairs of state. There were reports and petitions. ⁴ They went to the Southern Office. ⁵ Then they moved to the royal residential palace. On this day, eight horses from the royal pastures of Chichibu in Musashi province were presented. The horses were fewer in number [than expected]. The Left and Right stable bureaus divided and distributed the horses between themselves.

22nd day. *Jinshi* [49th day of the sexagenary cycle]. The sky was clear. The Noble in Charge did not attend. Consequently, there were no affairs of state. In the afternoon, the Supernumerary Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Sanesuke, Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kanetada, Advisors Lord Fujiwara no Kanehira, Lord Fujiwara no Tadasuke, and Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari entered the Residential Palace. Then they each withdrew.

23rd day. $Kich\bar{u}$ [50th day of the sexagenary cycle]. The sky was clear. Middle Counselor Fujiwara no Kintō, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Tadanobu, Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Arikuni, and Lord Minamoto no Toshikata arrived at the Council Secretaries' Office, and they attended to state affairs. [Text missing] They went to the Preparatory Office for a document checking session. Senior Controller of the Left Lord Fujiwara no Tadasuke went to the Southern Office and then moved to the residential palace. Then everyone withdrew.

24th day. *Kōin* [51st day of the sexagenary cycle]. It was a day off.⁸

25th day. *Itsubo* [52nd day of the sexagenary cycle]. The sky was clear. Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kintō arrived at the Inner Palace Guardroom. However, because the advisors did not attend, there were no affairs of state. In the afternoon, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Takaie and Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari entered and arrived at the Left Guardroom. Then everyone withdrew.

26th day. *Heishin* [53rd day of the sexagenary cycle]. The weather was clear. Middle Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Kintō, Advisor Lord Fujiwara no Arikuni, and Advisor Lord Minamoto no

There were two possible locations, one in the Council Secretaries' Office and one in the Controllers' Office - here it is most likely the Council Secretaries' Office. Both the controllers and council secretaries would participate in these preparations.

Toshikata entered the Council Secretaries' Office and attended to affairs of state. Senior Controller of the Right Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari entered the Chamberlain's Office. Then he moved to the Right Guardroom in the Residential Palace. Then everyone withdrew.

27th day. *Teishi* [54th day of the sexagenary cycle]. The Minister of the Left went [to the residential palace]. He summoned a council secretary. Beginning tomorrow there should be a Ceremony for Appointment of Non-capital-based Officials. ¹⁰ The minister ordered the Council Secretary to direct the senior nobles to assemble. Having received this order, the Council Secretary returned to the Council Secretaries' Office to call for messengers and to give them orders.

28th day. Bogo [55th day of the sexagenary cycle].

29th Day. *Kibi* [56th day of the sexagenary cycle]. The weather was clear. The Minister of the Left, the Minister of the Right, the Inner Palace Minister, the Senior Counselor Lord Fujiwara no Michitsuna, Supernumerary Senior Counselor Lord [Fujiwara no] Sanesuke, Senior Counselor Lord [Fujiwara no] Kanetada, Middle Counselor Lord [Fujiwara no] Tokimitsu, [Middle Counselor] Lord [Fujiwara no] Kintō, Supernumerary Middle Counselor Lord [Fujiwara no] Tadanobu, [Supernumerary Middle Counselor] Lord [Fujiwara no] Takaie, Advisor Lord [Fujiwara no] Arikuni, [Advisor] Lord [Fujiwara no] Kanehira, [Advisor] Lord [Fujiwara no] Tadasuke, Lord Minamoto no Toshikata, and Lord Fujiwara no Yukinari came to the Residential Palace. Then they all withdrew. That day, they decided there should be royal progresses to the Kamo and Iwashimizu Shrines. So they summoned the Yinyang Bureaa¹¹ to choose and submit a time and date for departure. The decision was that [the progress to] Iwashimizu [should take place] on the coming fourth day of the third month, and the [the progress to] Kamo [should take place] on the thirteenth day [of the same month].

30th day. *Kanshin* [57th day of the sexagenary cycle]. The various senior nobles all went [to the Residential Palace].
